

Effective December 19, 2019, TriCore Reference Laboratories will offer three new urine drug screening panels. The focus of these panels is for non-emergency outpatient clinics, including pain management and substance abuse monitoring clinics. Depending on the panel ordered, some or all positive results will also be confirmed using liquid chromatography-tandem mass spectrometry (LC-MS/MS).

NOTES

- The UPAIN panel will automatically perform confirmatory testing on Opiates and Benzodiazepines if they screen positive.
- The USAP panel will confirm any positive Benzos, Buprenorphine, and Amphetamines.
- The UDSCN panel will not confirm positives, it is only a screen. The UDSCNR panel will confirm all positive screens.
- THC is not included in any of these panels. If screening for THC is needed, test code UTHC can be added on to any order.
